

**DETAILS OF NUMISMATIC CURRENCY SETS**

The types of numismatic currency sets, as well as the issue quantity, issue price and unique features of each set, are listed in the table below.

\$50 Single Note	50,000	85	This folder contains a single \$50 commemorative note bearing a serial number with a special prefix 'SG50'. The serial number is also unique as the horizontal set is in brown colour while the vertical set is in blue colour.
\$50 3-in-1 Uncut Sheet	5,000	400	This folder contains an uncut sheet of three \$50 commemorative notes, each bearing a serial number with a special prefix 'SG50'. The serial number is also unique as the horizontal set is in brown colour while the vertical set is in blue colour.
\$10 3-in-1 Uncut Sheet	250 (50 sheets per design)	200	This folder contains an uncut sheet of three \$10 commemorative notes of the same design (total – 5 designs).
Identical Numbered Notes Set	5,000	300	This set contains one \$50 commemorative note and five \$10 commemorative notes of different back designs. All six notes share the same last six digits in their serial numbers.
Silver Set	1,000	300	This set consists of one \$5 silver proof colour coin and one \$50 commemorative note bearing a serial number with a special prefix 'SG50'. The serial number of the \$50 note is also unique as the horizontal set is in brown colour while the vertical set is in blue colour.
Gold Set	150	1,400	This set consists of one \$50 gold proof coin and one \$50 commemorative note bearing a serial number with a special prefix 'SG50'. The serial number of the \$50 note is also unique as the horizontal set is in brown colour while the vertical set is in blue colour.
Platinum Set	100	2,000	This set consists of one \$2 cupro-nickel proof-like
